By certified letters dated September 12, 2005 ("Must-Carry Letters"), and pursuant to Section 76.64(f) of the Commission's Rules, the Station requested must carry status for the current triennial carriage cycle. As the Must-Carry Letters demonstrated, you are obligated to carry the Station because both the Station and your cable systems are located within the Los Angeles DMA, and because the Station has returned its analog spectrum allocation and is broadcasting on a digital-only basis. *See Memorandum and Opinion Order and Notice of Proposed Rulemaking*, CS Docket No. 98-120, 15 FCC Rcd 20845, 20872 (2000).

More than 30 days have elapsed since KVMD's request, and you have failed to satisfy your carriage obligations vis-à-vis the Station by informing the Station of your cable system's agreement to commence such carriage as of January 1, 2006. In fact, KVMD has received no response from Comcast Communications Cable Co.. Accordingly, KVMD hereby submits this formal demand for carriage pursuant to Section 76.61(a)(1).
