Pursuant to the provisions of Section 614 of the Cable Television Consumer Protection and Competition Act of 1992, and Section 76.64(f) of the Rules and Regulations of the Federal Communications Commission, this will inform you that Television Station KVMD DT, licensed to Twentynine Palms, California, elects mandatory carriage pursuant to Section 76.56(b) on your systems serving the communities of Canyon Country, Castaic, North Valencia, Saugus, Valencia, Burbank, Kagel Canyon, La Crescenta, Lake View Terrace, Pacoima, San Fernando, Shadow Hills, Sun Valley, Sunland, Sylmar, Tujunga, Culver City, Hollywood, Los Angeles, Mar Vista, Marina Del Rey, Palms, Venice, West Hollywood, Baldwin Hills, Hawthorne, Ladera Heights, Lennox, Playa Del Rey, Rancho Park, View Park, Westchester, Windsor Hills, Harbor City, Lomita, San Pedro, Torrance, Wilmington, Inglewood, Claremont, Pomona, Bell, Cudahy, Artesia, Bell Gardens, Bellflower, Downey, La Mirada, Lynwood, Maywood, Paramount, Lakewood, Athens, Compton, Florence, Huntington Park, Rancho Dominguez, South El Monte, Willowbrook, Carson, Dominguez, Hawaiian Gardens, Charter Oak, Covina, La Verne, Phillips Ranch, Pomona, Costa Mesa, Newport Beach, Santa Ana, Tustin, Cypress, La Palma, Canyon Lake, Corona, Homeland, Lake Elsinore, Lake Elsinore Valley, Lakeland Village, Meadowbrook, Menifee, Murrieta, Quail Valley, Sedco, Murrieta Hot Springs, The Farm, Wildomar, Corona, Coronita, El Cerrito, Riverside, California and any other cities, communities and unincorporated portions of the counties served by your systems, which are within the Los Angeles DMA. The Station is a digital-only station licensed to a community within the Los Angeles DMA and is therefore entitled to mandatory carriage. See WHDT-DT, 16 FCC Rcd 2692 (2001).

KVMD intends to provide its digital signal to cable systems over-the-air or where necessary, by alternative means of delivery, in order to ensure that a good quality

signal will be received at all cable headends. (We are electing , subject to any changes in law requiring digital carriage as well, that your cable system carry KVMD's signal in a converted analog mode and will be providing, at our expense, conversion equipment necessary to translate the signal to analog). Please arrange for a member of your staff responsible for engineering issues to communicate immediately with me (Lawrence (Larry) C. Peterson, General Manager) so that arrangements can be made for the timely installation of the required equipment.

This will further notify you that the Station requests carriage on cable channel 23, which is the Station's authorized DTV channel.

Please contact the undersigned should you have any objections to this mandatory carriage and channel position election.
