Pursuant to the provisions of Section 614 of the Cable Television Consumer Protection and Competition Act of 1992, and Section 76.64(f) of the Rules and Regulations of the Federal Communications Commission, this will inform you that Television Station KVMD DT, licensed to Twentynine Palms, California, elects mandatory carriage pursuant to Section 76.56(b) on your systems serving the communities of Agean Hills, Aliso Viejo, Capistrano Beach, Corona Del Mar, Coto De Caza Canyon, Dana Point, El Toro, El Toro MCB, Emerald Bay, Foothill Ranch, Irvine, Laguna Beach, Laguna Hills, Laguna Niguel, Lake Forest, Mission Viejo, Modjeska Canyon, Newport Beach, Orange, Rancho Santa Margarita, San Clemente, San Onofre, Silverado, Silverado Canyon, South Laguna, Trabucco Canyon, Tustin, Palos Verdes Estates, Rancho Palos Verdes, Rolling Hills, Palos Verdes Peninsula, Rolling Hills Estate, San Pedro, California and any other cities, communities and unincorporated portions of the counties served by your systems, which are within the Los Angeles DMA.
