KVMD Licensee Co., LLC ("KVMD"), the licensee of Station KVMD-DT, Twentynine Palms, California (the "Station"), hereby demands mandatory carriage of the Station's signal, pursuant to Section 76.61(a)(1) of the Commission's Rules, on your cable systems serving the communities of Barstow, unincorporated San Bernardino County, Marine Corps Logistics Base, Daggett, Hinkley, Lenwood, Yermo, San Fernando, Santa Clarita, unincorporated areas of Los Angeles County and discrete areas of the City of Los Angeles known as Canoga Park, Chatsworth, Encino, Granada Hills, Northridge, Reseda, Sepulveda, Sherman Oaks, Tarzana, Van Nuys, West Hills and Woodland Hills, Gardena, Hawthorne, El Segundo, Lawndale, Torrance, North Torrance, South Pasadena, San Marino, Orange, Orange County, Garden Grove, Los Alamitos, Huntington Beach, Westminster, Stanton, Fountain Valley, Rossmore, Midway City and Cypress, California, and any other cities, communities and unincorporated portions of the counties served by your systems, which are within the Los Angeles DMA.

By certified letters dated August 11, 2005 ("Must-Carry Letters"), and pursuant to Section 76.64(f) of the Commission's Rules, the Station requested must carry status for the current triennial carriage cycle. As the Must-Carry Letters demonstrated, you are obligated to carry the Station because both the Station and your cable systems are located within the Los Angeles DMA, and because the Station has returned its analog spectrum allocation and is broadcasting on a

digital-only basis. See *Memorandum and Opinion Order and Notice of Proposed Rulemaking*, CS Docket No. 98-120, 15 FCC Rcd 20845, 20872 (2000).

More than 30 days have elapsed since KVMD's request, and you have failed to satisfy your carriage obligations vis-à-vis the Station by informing the Station of your cable system's agreement to commence such carriage as of January 1, 2006. In fact, KVMD has received no response from Time Warner Cable. Accordingly, KVMD hereby submits this formal demand for carriage pursuant to Section 76.61(a)(1).
